



Who can deduct moving expenses?

You can deduct eligible moving expenses from income you earn at your new location if you move to start a job or a business, or attend courses as a full time or co-operative student at a college, university, or other institution offering post secondary education.

Your new home must be at least 40 kilometres (by the shortest usual public route) closer to your new school or place of work than your previous home.

Generally, your move must be from one place in Canada to another place in Canada
